About: Visual Art Contest – for ages 5-11

For children ages 5-11, a single entry of visual art will be accepted.

Visual art. Submit visual art on a flat standard 8.5x11 piece of paper. Examples of visual art that will be accepted: drawings, photos, collages, storytelling, painting, and other forms expressed on flat surfaces.

To submit visual art to the contest:

- 1) Snap a photo of the art on your phone
- 2) Post the photo to Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter with the hashtag: **#sjvaxforthewin**

About: Video Art Contest – for ages 12-18

For youth ages 12-18, a single entry of video art will be accepted.

Video art. Videos must be at least 15 seconds and no longer than 1 minute. Examples of video art that will be accepted: real, virtual, machinima, interactive, poetry, music, graphics, video shorts, storytelling, and other forms of video art.

To submit video art to the contest:

- 1) Post your video to Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter with the hashtag: **#sjvaxforthewin**

Artwork Authorization

Artwork submissions may be used as part of future public health messaging campaigns. By submitting artwork to the contest, you are agreeing to allow your artwork (or your child's artwork) to be used by Public Health Services of San Joaquin County, the Community Foundation of San Joaquin, Kaiser Permanente, and/or other public health messaging campaigns approved by the Community Foundation of San Joaquin.

Here is how the contest works

I. Eligibility requirements

Be sure you meet the following eligibility requirements before posting your art:

- This contest is open to San Joaquin County residents only.
- Employees of San Joaquin County Public Health Services, CodeStack, and Community Foundation of San Joaquin and their immediate families cannot participate in the contest.
- You must be between the ages of 5-11 to enter the visual art contest, or between the ages of 12-18 to enter the video art contest.
- You must have a parent's or guardian's approval to compete if you are under age 18.
- Art must be posted on an authorized, and monitored, social media account. **Contest winners will be contacted through the social media account where the art was submitted.**
- **Be sure the social media profile where the art is being posted is public, otherwise your art will not be viewable by the contest review committee.**

II. Registration

There is no registration required, however, your art must be posted to Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter (with the hashtag #sjvaxforthewin) through a publicly viewable account that is monitored and checked regularly. Winners will be contacted through the social media account where the winning art was submitted. In many cases this may be a parent or guardian's account. Only a single entry is allowed per person.

III. Working on your art

Before you start, make sure you know the rules and the question that must be answered through your expression of art. There are requirements for submitting visual art, as well as limits on video art length and what content is allowed. If your art doesn't answer the question, it may not be approved.

When working on your art, be sure to plan it out, be original, be creative, be real, be safe, and have fun!



Be sure to only use material in your art that is your original work, unless you have the permission to do so (such as music, images, sounds, costumes, etc.) Make it your own art and respect the work of others. If you are using music, images or sounds created by someone else, make sure it doesn't violate any copyright rules.

IV. Submit your art by the entry deadline: November 5, 2021 @ 5:00pm PST

Be sure your art meets all of the requirements before you submit it, otherwise it will not be allowed into the contest. Make sure you answer the question! If you're submitting a video, be sure any narration can clearly be heard over any background music or noise.

Once you're ready to submit it, post the art to Facebook, Instagram, or Twitter with the hashtag **#sjvaxforthewin**. If your art meets the eligibility requirements, it will be reviewed along with other art submissions to the contest. All entries **MUST** be submitted by the deadline to be considered for the contest.

Before you submit your art, make sure it meets these eligibility requirements:

- it is your own original work.
- if *visual art*, it must be submitted on a single flat standard 8.5x11 piece of paper.
- if *video art*, it must be a minimum of 15 seconds and no longer than 1 minute in length, where the audio/voice can be heard clearly over the music or background sounds.
- in the creation of your art, please adhere to [California's current safety measures](#) regarding COVID-19.
- it contains appropriate content (language and images.)
- it is respectful of copyrights and respectful of others (you must have permission to use other people's music, company logos, images, or photos, and list your sources in your entry description or in your video credits, if submitting a video.)

V. Sharing your art

This contest is about celebrating our community, encourage others to get the COVID-19 vaccine, and moving forward from the COVID-19 pandemic. Please join us by being a positive, good messenger and share your art with as many people as you can! Let your friends, family, neighbors, classmates, and others know about your art and about the contest.
